



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to the Teacher Education Program, students must meet the following minimum requirements at the time they apply:

- Complete a minimum of 54 semester hours of course work.
Attain an overall GPA of 2.75 on a minimum of 12 semester hours of course work at TCU.
Complete a course in speech and EDUC 20003 with a grade of C or better, and an acceptable admissions screening report.
Complete 12 hours of content area coursework (15 hours required for content area math and science coursework).
Achieve a grade of C or better in all content area and education courses taken prior to admission.
Complete record of current (within one year) group one criminal record check.
Attach FERPA agreement.
Attach signed Ethics Statement or Certificate of Ethics Training.
For the 2018-2019 academic year and beyond, certification candidates enrolled in the program will pay a fee of \$35. The fee will appear on your TCU student account.
Attach required scores (ACT and SAT scores must not be older than five years) on one of the following tests:
TSI: Reading 351; Math 350; Writing 350
ACT: Composite 23; Reading 19, Math 19
OLD SAT (Before March 2016): Composite 1570; 500 in Verbal, Math & Writing
NEW SAT (After March 2016): Composite 1090
